Rules and Regulations

- Table Rental- **\$20.00 (\$15 Fall & Winter)** per table per day
- Hours of Operation 4pm-7pm (3:00-6:00 Fall & Winter)
- Doors open at 1pm for set up.
- Vendors are to be set up and prepared for sales at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the market.
- Immediately after unloading, vendors are required to move their vehicle/s away from the doors. (Please ensure that your vehicles are not blocking entrances of all doors)
- The main gates into the ag society need to be kept clear so that trucks and trailers can access the riding arenas with livestock. This facility is home to many events so please be respectful of these other events that may be happening at the same time.
- Vendors are **required** to stay until **the end of the market** at which time they may begin to pack up and carry out their products. ***Vendors packing up early may be dismissed from attending any further markets.***
- Vendors handling food must adhere to local Food Safety guidelines. All vendors selling ANY food products must have the Farmers' Market Home Study Course Certificate (Food Handling Safety Course) and provide the Farmers' Market Manager a copy of their certificate. The certificate must also be displayed on your table during the market.
- Health regulations according to the Regional Health Authority shall be strictly adhered to at all times.
- The price of each product must be visible.
- The sale of any **flea market (used, second hand, antique)** products is prohibited.
- This is a food establishment. **NO SMOKING OR ANIMALS** allowed within the market premises.
- We are an indoor and outdoor market.
- Vendors shall conduct themselves at all times in a courteous and business-like manner. Rude, abrasive, offensive and other disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.
