Classes and Stalling

- 1. Purebred and percentage cattle carrying a breed association paper will show in that breed class. Commercial cattle will show as AOB.
- 2. Stalling will be limited with no additional tack space outside of the space that you book. Heifers and bulls will be shown on separate days, therefore cattle can be stalled in tie outs on the off day of their show, if exhibitors want to bring more than what fits in the allotted stall.
- 3. There must be a minimum of 5 head entered to make up a breed class
- 4. Stalling will be assigned after entries are closed and upon receipt of your payment. Allocation of space is at the discretion of Stettler District Agricultural Society (SAS) board of directors. Animals from each exhibitor will be stalled together

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Cancellation of entries and/or space is non-refundable.
- 2. Exhibitors may not hold Stettler District Agricultural Society (SAS) liable for any damage, expense or liability arising from any injury or damage to the exhibitor or to the property of the exhibitor in or around the building.
- 3. SAS assumes no responsibility for damage to exhibitors property for the duration of the show.
- 4. Alcohol consumption will only be permitted in licensed areas. No outside liquor allowed.
- 5. No smoking in any of SAS facilities.
- 6. No sharing or subletting of space will be allowed.
- 7. All animals must have CCIA approved tags.
- 8. All cattle in attendance must be free of infectious and contagious diseases. (i.e. ringworm)
- 9. Neck ropes are mandatory for all animals. Any unruly animal will be gated or removed at the discretion of the Barn Boss.
- 10. Livestock exhibitors and animals will be asked to leave the premises for health and safety reasons, or failure to comply with the above rules and regulations.
